

**Let's Practice Jesus' Blessed Life!  
Jesus' Sermon On The Mount Teaches Us How To Build Our Home Wisely**

***Do Not Resist An Evil Person***  
**Matthew 5:38-42**

*"You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.' But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also. And if someone wants to sue you and take your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles. Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.*

**Jesus blesses us with His surpassing righteousness to fulfill the Law's \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. ...For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven.*  
**Matthew 5:17, 20**

**For example,**

*You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.' But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. V. 38*  
**Exodus 21:24; 1 Samuel 25:33; 26:10, 11**

**Case #1: when insulted, be \_\_\_\_\_.**

*But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also. V. 39*

**How Jesus practiced what He preached: John 18:22-23**

**Case #2: When sued, be \_\_\_\_\_.**

*And if someone wants to sue you and take your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. V. 40*

**How Jesus practiced what He preached: Matthew 12: 14, 15**

**Case #3: When imposed upon, be \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles.* V. 41

**How Jesus practiced what He preached: Luke 23:8, 9**

**Case #4: When asked, give what is \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.* v. 42  
**Deuteronomy 15:7-11**

**How Jesus practiced what He preached: Matthew 20:20-23**

**Bottom Line:**
